## Stephen Ministry - "Christ Caring for People Through People"

*"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God."*

~2 Corinthians 1:3-4

I believe this verse with all my heart. I have found it to be so true in my life as a receiver of care from God, through others, and for others as a care giver myself. Therefore, last July when I went to Dallas for Stephen Ministry Leadership Training, I entered what I believe will be yet another wonderful phase of my life! You see, I have known and been surrounded by The Stephen Ministry Series for years. At King of Glory, Dallas, where it was an established ministry, I took caregiver training to help in my work with young people as their new youth director; later on during both my internship at Preston Meadow, Plano and my first call at St. Paul, New Braunfels, the congregations entered into the ministry program and I heard all about leadership training from the other pastors and lay people who attended. I have seen the program begun, grow and blossom

to be a blessing to many people. Therefore my joy and expectations were high when the council at this St. Paul approved enrolling in the ministry program and I would be the pastoral leader! Given my extended units in Clinical Pastoral Education at Methodist Hospitals and my training and certification as a "Pastoral Care Specialist," Stephen Ministry Leadership seemed to be the link in ministry for which I was



longing! So... now what do I say? Tremendous blessing! Fantastic training! Exciting experience! Being trained and now having led a training class myself, I am more convinced than ever and very anxious as I watch and wait for the ministry to blossom and grow here.

What is Stephen Ministry? Stephen Ministry is *well trained, caring lay people giving distinctively Christian care-giving to others in a confidential relationship.* Stephen Ministers do not take the place of pastors but walk alongside pastors in extending care *in a longer term, intentional and personal way* than most pastors have the time to do given the amount of people who need care in average con-

gregations. Stephen Ministers, meeting one-to-one (men with men and women with women) each week listen, reflect, support and encourage people going through difficult times *for as long as they are needed*. Stephen Ministers share scripture, pray with and for the care receiver, and give freely of themselves as they are called to do. It is a major calling. I am thrilled that Kathy Peters (Congregational Council Lay Minister) was willing and able to attend leadership training with me and will be instrumental in the administrative details of the ministry. I am elated that eight outstanding, compassionate and faith-filled persons of this congregation heard God’s call to join us and be trained to serve. I am pleased and proud – after commissioning them at the services on Pentecost Sunday - to introduce them to you again through this newsletter:

**Hal Batzloff** – is Financial Controller for a major firm in Los Angeles as well as a Reserve Deputy for the Los Angeles County Sheriff. He has been at SPLC for ten years and was formerly active with the St. Elizabeth’s Care Team; served on the Congregational Council; and as Congregation President. Hal has chosen Galatians 5:13 as his Stephen Ministry scripture verse.

**Kathleen Peters** – has been an active member of St. Paul over thirteen years serving on council, altar guild,

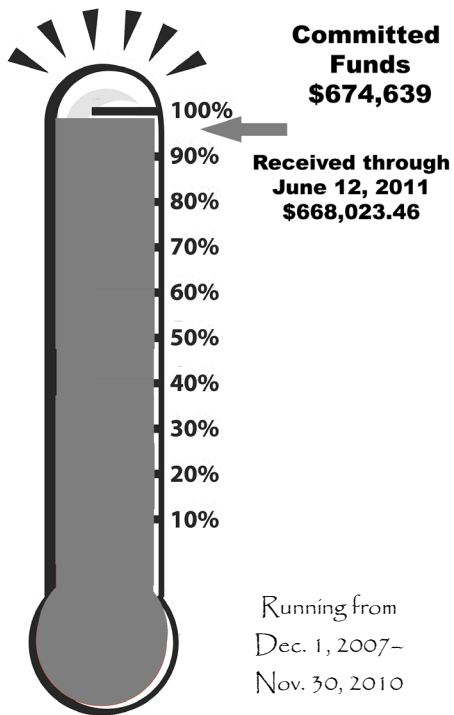

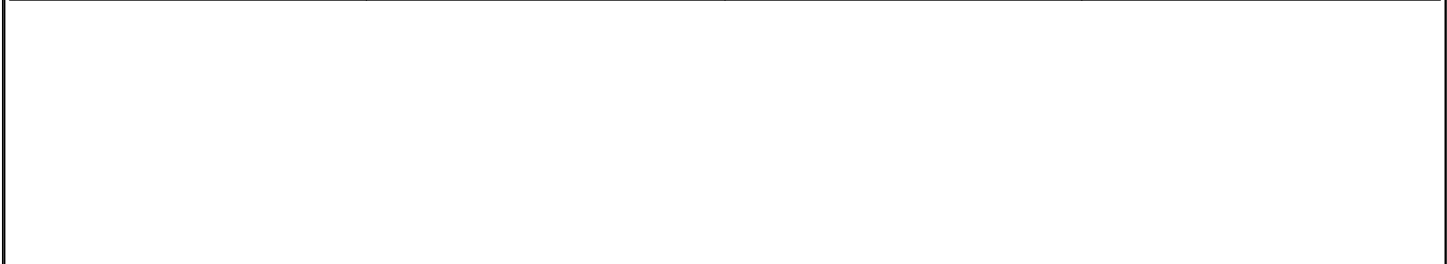

Beach Day

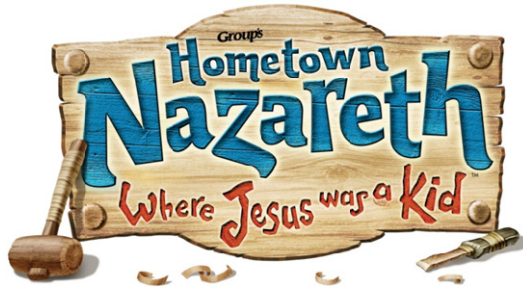
Sunday, July 24
